1. Call to Order

Chairman Gary Myers called the meeting to order.

2. Consent Agenda

3. Discuss changing the benefit formula and take any necessary action

Chairman Myers stated the Actuary depicts benefits can be changed and increased up to 4 years. He expressed concern changing the formula with the current financials and would rather have a cushion and give back to the members that took a cut.

Mr. Scott Safford suggested to increase the benefit formula by 2% through 2020 noting the plan is in good standings. He stated a 2% increase is conservative.

Mayor David Hill referenced Senate Bill 2 that recently passed noting it will affect the city's finances. He recommended having a discussion with Finance Director Charles Harris before taking action.

After further discussion, it was determined to consider changing the benefit formula at the next meeting.

4. Discuss going out for Request for Proposals for a new Investment Consultant and take any necessary action

Chairman Myers stated Mr. Tim Sharpe has been the Funds investment consultant since 2000 and since his untimely passing, the Fund has been assigned to Graystone Consulting Tampa Service Team. He explained they will support the servicing effort along with the portfolio and Ms. Pam Dunn from the Austin office will be available for operation questions. Chairman Myers recommended to seek Request for Proposals for a new Investment Consultant.

After further discussion, it was suggested to contact other funds for potential investment consultants.

Action:

Mr. Scott Safford moved to go out for Request for Proposals for a new Investment Consultant. Mr. John Tillery seconded, All Ayes.
