6. Consider financial report on Senior Center, Inc. for period ending December 28, 2022

John Smith, Assistant Director, Senior Center, provided a financial report noting the current balance is showing negative for December's statement but there are two large January deposits that will be reflected on January's statement. With the two large deposits, the actual ending balance is \$82,250.

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The Gryphons Motorcycle Club contributed a cash donation of \$7,300 from the Santa Run for the Senior Center members. Mr. Smith will be reviewing ways to use and distribute the donated funds for members.

7. Discuss and consider upcoming Senior Center activities

Mr. Smith reviewed previous Senior Center activities including Be a Santa to a Senior, Halloween Carnival, Veterans Celebration, Junk in the Trunk, and field trips to the North Park Mall. Mr. Smith stated there were 675 gifts collected for the Be a Santa to a Senior program, 375 were distributed to nursing homes, and 300 were distributed to Meals on Wheels. Mr. Smith also announced the upcoming Senior Center Valentine's Day Dance.

8. Discuss and consider request for large ceiling fan in multi-purpose room

Mr. Smith expressed the need of a new ceiling fan for the multi-purpose room and asked the board to consider and approve the purchase of a new fan. The budget for purchasing and installing a new large ceiling fan is \$11,000.

Ms. Saunders moved to approve the purchase of a large ceiling fan in the multi-purpose room in the amount of \$11,000. Mr. Brad Burns seconded, All Ayes.
