#### **FESTIVAL & EVENT UPDATES**

The 2023 Waxahachie holiday season resulted in several successful events with growing attendance: Christmas Parade & Tree Lighting, Bethlehem Revisited, Christmas Tour of Homes, Santa Run, 12 Beers of Christmas Stroll, and more.

With 2023 in the rearview mirror, the windshield of 2024 looks big and promising. The first four months are action-packed with events like Hachie Gras, Tulipalooza, Ellis County Livestock Show & Rodeo, Hachie Eclipse of the Heart, Cowboy Poet Gathering, Big Top Shopping Festival, and much more.

#### **ADVERTISING, PR & MEDIA UPDATES**

- The New Year started off great with an article in the January/February 2024 issue of Texas Parks & Wildlife Magazine "Places in Their Hearts: A Weekend in Waxahachie Brings Encounters with A Historic Courthouse, Lovely Houses and a Handful of Movie Sites."
- We had a strong holiday marketing campaign that consisted of print, broadcast, digital and social media that resulted in a 9% traffic increase to

the downtown/historic overlay area per Placer.ai for the month of December 2023 compared to December 2022.


- The November e-blast (Holiday Preview) and December e-blast (Holiday Happenings) both resulted in an open rate of 28%.

Re: Update from Beautification – January 2024

### **Current Projects**

- Park Schoolhouse Median 5 & 6
  - The project scope entails 18 cedar elms spaced 60 feet apart down the middle of medians 5 and 6 will be installed towards the end of January.
  - A hand-picked selection of large limestone blocks will be used as landscaped accents. Chris has selected the blocks and awaiting delivery.
  - The landscape beds have been marked off with paint. Lantana will prep the beds by removing six inches of topsoil and replacing it with a landscape mix.
- Broadhead Road Median 6
  - Bermuda grass will be installed in May.
- Spring Blooming Bulbs
  - All of the bulbs have been planted in the flower and landscape beds.

 Chris reserved 3,000 bulbs to be planted in the planters in the upcoming weeks.


#### Maintenance

- Seasonal color transitions
  - Due to Stage 3 water restrictions, the decision was made to postpone changing out the majority of flower beds. Watering every day for the first 2 weeks after planting is critical. Stage 3 water restrictions will only allow watering for two days per week.

### **Completed Projects**

- Texas Parks and Wildlife Department Trout Partnership
  - o On December 4<sup>th</sup> TPWD stocked the Sports Complex, Belle Vue, and Mustang Creek ponds with 850 of the smaller trout for each pond.
  - o TPWD will come back in January and restock all three ponds with the same amount.
- Large Trout (Service Enhancement)
  - On December 6<sup>th</sup> Blessed Bayou Wildlife and Fisheries delivered the larger trout all the way from Missouri. The larger trout average between 1.5 – 2.0 lbs., and will be great for those wanting to fish at the local ponds and get that "big catch".
  - o They also brought one very large brooder trout that snuck into the tank while the others were being loaded loading. The larger brooder trout was release at Bell-vue pond.



1. Synthetic Turf Improvement Project Phase IV – The project is moving along with over 100 truckloads of dirt excavated from all three fields. Soil stabilizing chemical injections are complete. Testing to verify the soil stabilization is adequate will be performed to determine if additional stabilization is required.
