Please complete an application with membership fees due per fiscal year, October 1. Payment options and scholarships are available with qualification.

A PROSPECTIVE MEMBER MUST HAVE THE MENTAL
AND PHYSICAL ABILITY TO FUNCTION INDEPENDENTLY
WITHOUT STAFF OR VOLUNTEER SUPERVISION WHILE
AT THE CENTER.

It is mandatory for all members to sign in at the Kiosk upon arrival for scheduled events. Senior Center activities are determined by participation.

Members may bring guests up to six (6) times a year. Guest may observe or participate in class activities based on space availability.

All physical activities require a liability release form on file. <u>THE FITNESS CENTER IS FOR MEMBERS ONLY</u>. Guests and children are not permitted access to our fitness equipment.

Orientation for the use of the exercise rooms is mandatory for all members before using any equipment. Children under eighteen (18) may not participate in Senior Center activities unless during planned Intergenerational activities.

<u>A MEMBER MUST ACCOMPANY ALL GUESTS AT ALL</u> TIMES WHILE AT THE CENTER.

Reservations for lunch must be made by the participant either by registering on the computer at the front desk or call (469-309-4280) twenty-four (24) hours before scheduled lunch time.

The Center is not responsible for damage, breakage, theft, or storage of a participant's personal items. The Senior Center is not liable for personal injuries to people participating in the Center's activities. All members and guests must sign a liability release and it will be kept on file.

Please do not remove supplies, tools, or equipment from the Center unless written permission is approved by the Director.

Fees for classes and supplies are subject to change as per project.

CODE OF CONDUCT
